## **Presentations of CFFs about Plans of Next Two Years**

## 1. Presented by CFF Japan

- i. CFFJ will develop human resources to solve social issues as stated in the Youth Mutual Development Vision by offering them (youths) opportunities such as sharing and caring others, teaching them how to cooperate and take action.
- ii. CFFJ will create new activities for Youths participators which will help them solve social issues in real life.
- iii. For the CFF Supporter acquisition, CFFJ keep 25 units (25,000 yen per month) increase each year.
- iv. CFFJ is going to design new support plan by offering 10000 Yen discount for 20 students and 50% discount for 1 or 2 students under social welfare support for 2018 spring programs.
- v. CFFJ will enhance CFF Myanmar organization by helping and cooperating constantly.

#### 2. Presented by CFF Philippines

- i. CFFP is trying to establish CFF Village for the people with autism (the total cost will be P 48,512,734.52)
- ii. CFFP will maintain the age of admission from 4 to 12 years old.
- iii. CFFP will upgrade and expand facilities to be able to accommodate more children.
- iv. CFFP will create vocational trainings for children's better future and having a sense of personal and community responsibility.
- v. CFFP will locate families and relatives of the children under the foundation's care for possible reintegration or foster care.
- vi. CFFP will mobilize resources through linkages from different individuals and organizations.
- vii. CFFP will initiate new program initiative addressing the cause for "AUTISM" and establish networks.

### 3. Presented by CFF Malaysia

- i. CFFM will develop children to become who will care, love and respect themselves, those around them and their environment.
- ii. CFFM will equip children with essential skills (Academic & Practical) that will help them in their work.
- iii. CFFM will develop children with Godly values, and practice them in their daily lives.

#### 4. Presented by CFF Myanmar

- i. CFF MM will try to become legal local NGO.
- ii. CFF MM will provide health care for slum people such as donating mosquito-nets and building proper toilets by cooperating with the other CFFs.
- iii. CFF MM will try to give free basic education for slum children near Yangon.
- iv. CFF MM will help give vocational training for slum youths.

## 5. Question and Answer, Comments and Others

- 1) One participant from Japan shared why he is getting to participate in CFF
- He could do because he has a will.
- By participating in CFF, he could get what he can't get in Japan or outside society.
- 2) Malaysia Pastor, Mr. Chin Chi Kiong, said compliments to Japanese for their diligence and hard working.
- 3) One participant from Japan questioned CFF P
- Q: what is the purpose of CFF Village?
- A: the purpose of establishing CFF Village is to help the people with Autism mainly.
- Q: are there any help from Government?
- A: No. not at all. But the government inspects them on their performances.
- 4) Joseph asked for help from CFF J if possible
- -Joseph explained the cost for establishing CFF Village and asked for a help for one budget. But CFFJ responsed that it would be hard to find that budget.
- 5) Rev Dr. Maung Maung Yin said thanks to all CFF teams.

## 6. Compromising or Adjusting "Guideline for Cooperation with Overseas Partners"

- iv. The next CFF International Convention will be hosted in Philippines in 2019.
