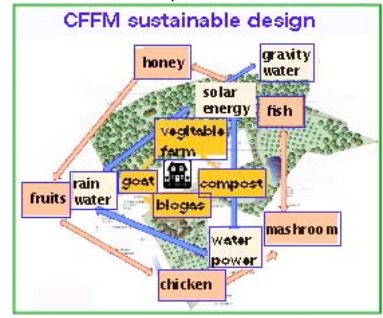

CFFM began in 2004 when Mr. Mitsuhiro Abe found God in calling in the street children in Kota Kinabalu. He decided to build "House for Kids" in Papar. 250 persons offered the donation for land purchase and infrastructures, realizing the vision and plan. Youths and volunteers make bridge, trails, meeting place in the site. The CFFM Cheering Party initiated "Thank-you project" aiming to collect \$50,600(160,000RM) from 390 persons in two years, and donated 3rd kid-house(2011) and a VAN(2012).
